NEW MODULE: ADDICTIONS/DATIS

Currently 3 agencies are using the DATIS interface in their "LIVE" (production) environment. Two additional agencies have begun preliminary set up. If you are currently using Catalyst and would like to switch to the CRMS Addictions/DATIS interface contact us for more information.

NEW MODULE: MEDICATION RECONCILIATION

A Pilot project is currently underway for this new module. It will be tested in a hospital environment over the next 6 months. This module will allow input of all current client/patient medications and quantities/dosages. A Nurse Practitioner or Psychiatrist will be able to reconcile any differences between the current medications. Allergies can be tracked as well as prescriptions, which can also be generated from the system. Reports required for accreditation and compliancy in Medical Reconciliation will be included. Ideal for hospitals or community based programs.

NEW MODULE: SCHEDULER

A full fledged Calendar Module, allows tracking of all worker appointments using CRMS. Ability to colour code appointments as defined by your internal CRMS Administrator. Enter Quick Contacts directly from the Calendar screen. Schedule appointments for Teams, Individuals, Resources such as room bookings, equipment along with ability to tie to a client if required. A test pilot is currently underway. Contact us for details and feedback results.

NEW MODULE: VOLUNTEER MANAGEMENT

Designed to collect information regarding Volunteers and their Activities. Ability to create Notes and track Time spent by each Volunteer plus time spent providing Peer Support to Clients. A maximum of 4-5 Pilot testing organizations. We have several organizations that have expressed an interest in participating but currently subject to funding resources.
